Pismo Beach mailman Paul Lee led a stalwart contingent of 17 runners to the finish line in Sunday's Lompoc Lizard Breath Fenceline Fun Run at La Purisima. Lee clocked 56 minutes and 5 seconds over the hilly, sandy 7.5-mile course. The tall, slender 45-year-old has now run at least three miles a day for 10,205 days in a row. "It hasn't gotten any easier," said Lee, who also won this event in 2004.

Lee was given solid competition by second-place Jim Curriden, a sprightly 47-year-old from Solvang who crossed the line in 57:56, and Robert Livingston, a 17-year-old from Tampa, Fla. who finished in third place at 58:42.

Angie Gonzalez, 30, of Lompoc was the women's winner in 1:07:20.
